

Author Guidelines ClinLab (Swiss Abstracts):

1. underline first author
2. Conclusions
3. Space before and after “=”, “<”, “>”, “≤”, “≥”, “-”, “+”, “x” (also in tables!!)
4. No space between figure and "%"; i.e.: 8%
5. Affiliation always with institution, town and country, numbering combined with the author
6. figures > 1000 with comma (1,000)
7. American English (e.g. etiological, tumor , programs, hemolytic etc.)
8. Abbreviations with “.” (vs., St., e.g.)
9. Hour(s), minute(s), second(s) spelled in full (not „h“, „min“, „sec“)
10. *in vitro*, *in vivo* italic!
11. Student’s *t*-test (“*t*” italic); Mann-Whitney *U* test (“*U*” italic)
12. Round bracket ()
13. “L” for liter always capital L (mL, μL, L)
14. “p” (p-value) always small, not italic
15. “n” always small, not italic
16. cutoff (no hyphen)
17. dot for decimal figures like: 1.25
18. no. – always without a double-dot following
19. Table 1., Figure 1. (capital letter “T” and “F”, dot after the number)
